At this portion of the meeting, the Board will discuss the Board of Education's interpretation of whether non-certified personnel (sometimes called "classified personnel") in school districts must have a fingerprint clearance card. If the Board of Education determines that classified personnel must have fingerprint clearance cards, the Board of Fingerprinting may adopt a revised budget and authorize new expenditures and personnel. The Board may also consider changing its portion of the fingerprint-clearance-card fee.
